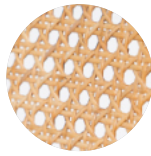

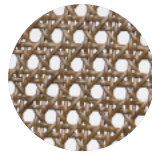

## PROTECTION/CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

**Upholstery:** To clean spills, grab a soft clean cloth or paper towel and use this to absorb any excess liquid. To clean off any residue liquid dampen a soft clean cloth with solution of warm pure soap/water or a chemically neutral cleaner and wipe away. Once clean use a clean dry cloth to dry the surface. Do not use furniture polish, abrasive or paste cleaners.

**Timber:** Do not use harsh cleaners or any solvents they will have damaging effects on the timber, breaking down the protective varnish and void any warranty. Follow with a dry cloth ensuring you always wipe in the direction of the wood grain.

**Protection:** We recommend trying to avoid placing furniture in direct heat or light, this can cause fading, discolouration and drying, leading to hardening of PVC, leatherette and woven plastic upholstery fabric. Heat can cause timber to crack, split and bow, while over exposure to sunlight can cause fading of your furniture.
